



PARENT/GUARDIAN GUIDELINES



DROP OFF / PICK UP

Each camp day starts at 9:00am and ends at 3:00pm. Supervision will be provided for campers dropped off at each camp venue from as early as 8:00am. All campers must be picked up by their parent/guardian **no later than 4:45pm.**

It is strongly advised that no child be picked up after 5:00pm as supervision is **NOT** guaranteed at any camp venue. If a late camper pick up is foreseen, we kindly ask parents/guardians to contact camp administration as soon as possible.

In keeping with procedures at Chuck E. Cheese's, all parents will receive numbered chits/tickets to be given to persons assigned for pick up. Campers can only be collected from the camp venue by persons with the correctly numbered ticket that corresponds to the registered camper. Persons assigned for pick up may be asked to show proof of identification by Camp Officials.

CAMP FEES/ALL INCLUSIVE PACKAGE

The camp fee covers the entire durations of the camp and it is inclusive of all camp materials and transportation for field trips etc. unless otherwise stated. In addition the camp fee includes a Chuck E. Cheese's camper package which includes lunch (two slices of cheese OR chicken pizza), unlimited drink refills and 16 game tokens each day.

Parents have the option to provide their own meals for campers if they so desire however the camp fee will remain the same. Parents are also advised that snacks will not be provided and these should be packed for each camper as they may not be available for purchase at each camp venue.

A change of clothing is recommended for the campers registered in the **5-7 years** camp age group. In addition, we ask that parents clearly label all items that campers bring to the camp e.g. lunch kits, backpacks, sweaters, etc.

CAMPER'S CODE OF CONDUCT

BEHAVIOUR

1. Campers should accept and get along with others. Teasing, practical jokes, harmful comments, etc. will not be tolerated from any camper.
2. Campers must be sensitive to others in terms of race, religion, physical characteristics and language. Ethnic or religious slurs or jokes will not be tolerated.
3. Campers must respect others (campers, camp counsellors and guests) and their property. Campers will refrain from touching others in harmful or inappropriate ways.
4. Campers must not use obscene language.

5. Campers must follow directions the first time they are given by counsellors, as they are for the safety of everyone on the camp site.
6. **Campers must refrain from excessive touching or signs of affection towards other campers and staff members.**

SAFETY

7. Campers should wear comfortable footwear. Closed-toe shoes are required for ALL sporting activities which may take place throughout the duration of the camp.
8. Campers must pay attention to their surroundings and use care in all activities.
9. Campers will adhere to all safety rules and regulations given for each activity and while using equipment related to the sessions that he/she participates in while at camp.

GENERAL

10. Campers are expected to wear appropriate clothing.

FEMALE: The following types of clothing **ARE NOT ALLOWED**: spaghetti/thin strapped tops, strapless/tube tops, revealing low cut tops, short shorts or very short skirts.

If leggings or tights are being worn, tops should be of an appropriate length.

MALE: The following types of clothing **ARE NOT ALLOWED**: vests, very baggy/saggy/tight pants, excessive jewellery.

Note: Hats can be worn to and from camp and during outdoor activities, but they cannot be worn indoors.

11. Campers must inform staff if they are experiencing a problem with another camper or other issues. If we are not informed about a problem, we cannot stop the problem or assist the camper.
12. **Electronic devices of any kind (iPod, PSP, Nintendo DS, tablets, etc.) are NOT allowed at camp. NIHERST/Chuck E. Cheese's will not be responsible for the damage to or loss of these items if brought.**

Students who need to bring cell phones will not be allowed to use them during camp hours without Camp Administration permission.

13. Campers who steal or maliciously vandalise NIHERST property and/or external camp venues will be required to replace the damaged/stolen item at their Parent/Guardian's expense.
14. In the case of theft, grounds for dismissal depending on severity may occur.
15. Violation of the **CODE OF CONDUCT** can be grounds for automatic dismissal depending on the severity. Refunds are not given when a camper is dismissed from the programme.
