

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS – VOLUNTEERS

1. What do volunteers do at the National Championship?

There are various roles that need to be executed at the National Championship e.g. Crowd Control, Judges, Team Check-In Assistant etc. Volunteers will receive the relevant training for their assigned role.

2. Is there any kind of training?

Yes. All volunteers will receive training on their respective role before the actual day of the event. This training is expected to take place the Saturday before the event.

3. How many hours am I needed for?

Volunteers are asked to be at the venue from as early as 6:30am until the end of the tournament which is expected to end at 5:00pm provided all goes to plan. This includes a closing ceremony which volunteers are welcome to attend for the winner's announcement. If you have to leave by a specific time on the day please inform the Volunteer Coordinator as soon as possible preferable before the day of the training.

4. Will meals be provided?

Meals will be provided at both the training session and the National Championship. Please indicate your preference for vegetarian options as well as allergy information on the relevant Volunteer Registration Form.

5. Will transport be provided?

Transport will not be provided, however, at the Training Session, carpool arrangements are usually made amongst the volunteers to ensure everyone has transport to and from the venue.

6. Will parking be available?

Yes, we will allocate a designated area for volunteers to park their vehicle.

7. What should I wear?

Volunteers will be receiving a FIRST® LEGO® League Trinidad & Tobago polo/t-shirt which they will wear on the day of the event. Volunteers are expected to wear comfortable jeans/long skirts and footwear.

NB: Clothing should not be too tight or revealing. No offensive or obscene prints.

8. Do I need to bring any special supplies?

No, volunteers are not required to bring anything specific. NIHERST will receive all the necessary information needed from volunteers from the Registration Form.
