Questions & Answers

1. What are the iSTEM Club times?

The club intends to meet on six (6) Saturdays (9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon) per term.

2. What is the iSTEM Club venue?

National Science Centre, D' Abadie

3. Is there a registration fee?

\$300 per term per child

A two-part payment plan can be taken whereby 50% (\$150) is due at the first session and the other 50% (\$150) is due on the third session. (Cash or cheque)

4. Where can I pay the registration fee?

Registration will be done at the National Science Centre in D' Abadie, and you can pay the club fee during registration. Payment can be made by cash and cheque ONLY. Online registration is not available.

5. Can I register outside of the age range?

Yes. In the case of 4 year olds, the child must be turning 5 by 31st December, 2019; evidence via birth certificate must be shown at the point of registration.

6. Will the same content be taught at each academic term?

Once space is available you will be allowed to register your child, however there will be no reduction to the club fee.

8. Are lunch and snacks provided?

9. What should my child/children walk with to club?

Members should bring a jacket as the camp venues are air-conditioned.
