FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

 What are the camps about? What are the topics/themes for each camp? Ultim8 STEM! 1-Day camps use hands-on activities to inspire and educate aboutphenomena in the natural and physical world. All activities are designed to stimulatecampers' curiosity in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) and tobuild critical 21st century skills.

The following camp themes will be available during this camp cycle:

Camp Rock	Unfold the Earth's story beneath your fingertips and uncover its stony science secrets. Gems, crystals and many other hidden treasures await in this wild geology ride where every discovery rocks!

2. <u>What are the camp times?</u>

Camps run from **9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.** Your child can be dropped off as early as 8:30 a.m. and must be collected no later than 3:00 p.m.

3. What are the camp venues and dates?

Four 1-day camps will be conducted at the <u>Arima Community Centre</u> from **Monday 25th March - Thursday 28th March**; followed by four 1-day camps conducted at the <u>Barataria Community Centre</u> from **Tuesday 2nd April - Friday 5th April 2024.** Refer to the table below for 1-day camp themes respective to date and location:

4. How can I register?

The registration process is done entirely online.

You can register using the Registration Link <u>HERE (click)</u> or on our website and social media platforms (<u>Facebook</u>, <u>Instagram</u> or <u>Twitter</u>). Once the registration form is submitted, you will receive instructions for payment. *Please note that your child's spot is not guaranteed until you make your payment*.

Once we confirm your payment on our end, you will be notified of your confirmed registration status.

5. <u>Is there a registration fee?</u>

Yes. The registration fee per camp is TTD\$100.00. **Materials and supplies are included.**

Price for each 1-day camp: \$100.00

6. How can I pay the registration fee?

Upon submission of your completed online registration form(s), you will receive an email with instructions on how to make payment. At present, we will be accepting direct deposits (over-the-counter bank transactions, fast deposits, online banking transfers).

Please note you are required to retain a screenshot or photo of your proof of payment to submit to us via email (campadmin@niherst.gov.tt) as this is what will be used to confirm your spot in the camp once space is available.

7. Can I register outside of the age range?

Registrations outside of the age ranges will not be permitted.

8. <u>Can I register for more than one location?</u>

Yes. You can register for camps at both locations (for different themes).

9. Can I register for multiple themes?

Each differently theme camp will cover different content. You can register for multiple themes.

10. <u>Can I register on the same day as the camp?</u>

Registration on the same day of the camp will not be facilitated. Registration for each camp will be closed at noon two (2) business days before each camp's date, or earlier as necessary if the camp becomes full.

11. Is my spot confirmed once I submit my registration form?

No. Submission of the registration form creates a "Pending Registration" status for your child/children. Your spot is only confirmed after proof of payment is sent.

12. Are lunch and snacks provided?

Lunch and snacks are not provided.

13. <u>What should my child/children walk with to camp?</u>

Campers can walk with lunch as well as sufficient snacks and water as necessary. Campers should bring a jacket as the camp venues are air-conditioned. All items must be labeled with the camper's name.

14. <u>Will there be any field trips?</u>

No field trips have been scheduled for this camp cycle. Campers and facilitators will remain at each location for the entire day.

15. <u>Are parents allowed to attend field trips?</u>

There are no field trips.

16. Are parents allowed to remain on the camp site?

No. Parents are kindly asked to leave campers in the care of the camp facilitators once dropped off at the camp venue.

17. How many campers do you take in for each camp?

The number of campers depends on the venue and the specific camp. It ranges from 10-20 campers per age group.

18. <u>What is the ratio of facilitators to campers?</u>

1 counsellor : 10 campers.

19. Are background checks conducted on facilitators?

Facilitators for these camps are experienced, trained NIHERST staff. Any additional facilitators are interviewed and based on their performance are hired accordingly.

20. Can I get the facilitators' contact information?

21. Can I get a refund?
