Every year the U.S. embassy and the **National Institute of Higher Education, Research, Science and Technology (NIHERST)** accept applications from forth to sixth form students between the ages of 16-18 years old for a scholarship to attend the NYSCamp in West Virginia, USA.

Now in its 61st year, the NYSCamp is a residential Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) programme in the eastern mountains of West Virginia designed to honour and challenge some of the world's rising STEM leaders, provide them with opportunities to engage with STEM professionals and participate in exciting outdoor activities.

Support from the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs (https://eca.state.gov/) of the U.S. State Department allows Dominique Henry and Reginald Mohammed to attend the NYSCamp programme free of charge.
